### Arc Building Lowers GHG Emissions by 80 Tonnes

The Arc Building, located at 2955/57 Jutland Road in the beautiful Selkirk Waterfront, saw a reduction of 80 tonnes of Green House Gas emissions in 2007 over 2006. Energy upgrades to the building along with the excellent energy-saving practices of the tenants in the building resulted in 30% less gas and 15% less hydro consumption last year.

With further upgrades to the building planned in 2008, a new target for reduction of energy use has been set at 140 GHG tonnes to bring the total savings in Green House Gas emissions for 2007 and 2008 to an amazing 210 tonnes.

New opportunities for tenants to help the environment in the areas of water use and waste reduction as well as alternative transportation options will be showcased at the Arc Building throughout 2008.

The Ministry of Labour and Citizens' Services, Accommodation and Real Estate Services (ARES) and BC Hydro are key partners in the program to reduce energy use at the Arc Building.
